

At year end of 1994, there were 313 aircraft registered in Iceland, as compared to 319 the previous year, a drop of 2%. The number of registered aircraft is the lowest in the last six years.



Over the past ten years the number of Icelandic aircraft has increased by an average of 3% annually. The average annual change over the past five years is zero.

PERSONAL LICENCES




There were 1,865 valid personal licences at year end 1994, a drop of 3% from the previous year.

¹The main groups of licences include: private pilots = 599, commercial pilots = 452, aircraft maintenance technicians = 240, flight engineers = 47, air traffic controllers = 94, flight instructors = 91, student pilots = 91, flight dispatchers = 22 and glider pilots = 73. At year end 1994 there were 174 valid IFR licences.

From 1993 to 1994 the number of licences dropped in varying proportions in the following categories: student pilots 35%, flight dispatchers 49%, private pilots, commercial pilots and aircraft maintenance technicians 2% each, air traffic controllers 1%. The number of flight engineers with licences was unchanged, while glider pilots increase by 30% and flight instructors by 10%. Pilots with IFR licences increased by 14%.

Over the past ten years the number of valid personal licences has increased by an average of 2% annually. The average annual increase over the past five years is 4%.

REYKJAVÍK OCEANIC AIR TRAFFIC





68,697 aircraft entered the Reykjavík Oceanic Control Area in 1994, up 6% from the previous year, and the largest proportional annual increase since 1990.

Military air traffic has dropped steadily and comprised only 9% of total air traffic in 1994, while five years earlier the proportion was 15%.

Over the past ten years air traffic in the area has increased by an average of 4% annually. The average annual change over the past five years is -1%.

DOMESTIC PASSENGERS







348,921 domestic passengers embarked at Icelandic airports offering scheduled services in 1994, an increase of 7% from the previous year.

Over the past ten years the total number of domestic passengers embarking at airports with scheduled services has increased by an average of 1% annually. The average annual increase over the past five years is 19%.

INTERNATIONAL PASSENGERS






 $635,\!860$ international passengers used Icelandic airports with scheduled services in 1994, an increase of 12% from the previous year.

In 1994, in its first whole year of service, 868 international passengers used the new Egilsstaðir International Airport in the East Fiords.

Over the past five years the volume of international passengers at Keflavík International Airport has increased by an average of 3% annually. Keflavík is the main gateway for international air traffic to and from Iceland.

DOMESTIC MAIL AND CARGO



2,568 tons of mail and cargo were transported domestically in 1994, a drop of 7% from the previous year. Cargo transport declined by 2%, mail by 18%

Over the past ten years total domestic mail and cargo have dropped by an average of 6% annually. The average annual decrease over the past five years is 10%.


INTERNATIONAL MAIL AND CARGO



International mail and cargo increased 11% in 1994, amounting to a total of 15,318 tons. Cargo increased by 13%, mail by 1%.

Over the past five years international mail and cargo transported through the Keflavík International Airport has increased by an average of an annually. Keflavík is the main gateway for international air traffic to and from Iceland.

DOMESTIC AIRCRAFT MOVEMENTS



Domestic aircraft movements (take-offs and landings) increased in the area of scheduled and charter services by 6%, to a total of 62,682. Touchand-go landings numbered 51,873, a drop of 3%, and other domestic movements were 41,912 giving an increase of 7% over the previous year. Total aircraft movements at Icelandic airports with scheduled services in 1994 were 175,342, an increase of 2% from the previous year. 156,467 were domestic movements and 18,875 international movements.

Over the past ten years domestic aircraft movements have increased by an average of 2% annually. The average annual increase over the past five
