


## **AVIATION FACT FILE**

### Air Transport • Aircraft Fleet • Personal Licences • Air Traffic



There were 360 aircraft registered in Iceland at the end of 2001 as compared to 348 the previous year, an expansion of 3,4%. The number of heavy aircraft (over 5.700 kg) increased by 10 and light aircraft (under 5.700 kg) increased by 3. Number of gliders reduced by 1 and helicopters remain unchanged. Over the past ten years the number of Icelandic aircraft has increased by an average of 1,2% annually and 1,8% the last five years.



There were 2.064 valid personnel licences in the year 2001, an increase of 0,5% from the preceding year. The main groups of licences include: 647 commercial pilots, 597 private pilots, 297 aircraft maintenance technicians, 120 student pilots, 101 air traffic controllers, 44 flight dispatchers, 38 flight engineers and 40 glider pilots. From 2000 to 2001 the number of licences changed in varying porportions in the following categories: 7.4% air traffic controllers, 5.3% aircraft maintenance technicians and 5% commercial pilots, glider pilots by 5.3%. On the other hand, the number of private pilots diminished by 3.5%, student pilots by 8.4% and flight engineers by 7.3%. Over the past decade the number of valid licences has increased by an average of 3.9% annually and 3.7% over the past five years.






In all 87.337 aircraft entered the Reykjavík Oceanic Control Area in 2001, down 5,8% from the previous year. In 2001 commercial flights comprise 88% of the total air traffic, military flights 6% and general aviation account for 6%. Over the last ten years oceanic air traffic in the area has increased by an average of 3,2% annually. The average annual change over the past five years is an increase of 4,3%.



#### **Domestic Passengers**





In total lcelandic airports moved about 352.511 passengers in 2001, an decrease of 20,9% compared to 2000. Passenger traffic declined on all major airports offering scheduled services except at Bakkaflugvöllur which increased by 10%. An decrease of 35% at Hornafjörður, 32% at Vestmannaeyjar, 22% at Isafjörður, 21% at Reykjavík, 20% at Sauðárkrókur, 16% at Egilsstaðir, 15% at Akureyri and other airports by 51%. Over the past decade the total number of domestic passengers travelling at Icelandic airports has increased by an average of 0,6% annually. The average annual decrease over the past five years is 0,9%.



A total of 1.387.245 international passengers used Icelandic airports with scheduled services in 2001, an decrease of 6,5% from the preceding year. From 2000 to 2001 the number of international passengers went up by 1% in Reykjavík. An decrease of 6,5% in Keflavík, 73% in Egilsstaðir and 8,7% at Akureyri. Over the past ten years the volume of international passengers at Icelandic airports has increased by an average of 6,6% annually and 6% annually over the past five years.

#### Domestic Mail and Cargo




A total of 1.311 tonnes of cargo and mail were transported domestically in 2001, a drop of 26,6% from the preceding year. Cargo transport declined by 22,3% and mail by 61,4%. Over the past ten years total domestic cargo and mail have dropped by an average of 10,2% annually. The average annual decrease over the past five years is 8,8%.

International Mail and Cargo



In 2001 international cargo and mail traffic increased by 6,5% amounting to a total of 43.153 tonnes, near 2.600 tonnes more than in 2000. Cargo movement in 2001 was 41.387 tonnes while mail accounted for 1.766 tonnes. Cargo increased by 7,4%, or nearly 2.900 tonnes but mail decreased by 10,8%. Over the last decade total cargo and mail traffic increased by an average of 12,3% annually and by 12,7% over the past five years.



Total aircraft movements at Icelandic airports (take-off and landings) in 2001 were 200.839, a 9,6% decline from the previous year. Of the total movements 174.939 were domestic and 25.900 international. Scheduled and charter flights numbered 46.037 and decreased by 12,5%. Touchand-go landings numbered 85.551, a decrease of 8,2% and other domestic movements were 43.351 giving a decrease of 9% over the preceeding year.
